Please check in upon arrival at the trial site and present the dog's registration card, unless COVID-19 rules change. Please maintain social distancing.

This titling event is being held under the rules of the **Sporting Detection Dogs Association**. Open to all breeds & mixes of dogs. Dogs must be registered with the SDDA and be over six (6) months of age. Please advise us in advance if you will be bringing a bitch in heat. Unofficial scent not permitted on the trial site.

DOGS: Dogs must be under control at all times. This is a fully public venue so please keep barking to a minimum, pick up after your dogs promptly and note that your dog **MUST** be on leash when not crated or in the search areas. Any handler displaying inhumane or aggressive treatment of any dog, the public or other handlers (physically or verbally) will be asked to leave the premises without refund.

All dogs must be on a flat collar or harness in the search area. Leashes must be cloth or leather of any length in the search area. Use of retractable leashes or prong collars is **NOT** permitted on site.

COMPETITORS: through the submission of their entries, acknowledge that they know the Rules and Regulations. See Master Rule Book on the SDDA web site www.sportingdetectiondogs.ca to familiarize yourself with all rules.

Handler/Dog Teams may enter one or all components. All three (3) components (Container, Interior, Exterior) must be successfully completed (qualifying scores earned) at a level to earn a SD-S, SD-A or SD-Ex title; it is not necessary to complete all three on the same day, however the honorific SP (Special) will be added to the title of any dog who does complete the three components on the same day, at the same trial.

General Information:

Fees: Started, Advanced and Excellent: \$30 + HST (\$33.90) per component entered, **Elite:** \$90 + HST (\$101.70) and **Games:** \$25 + HST (\$28.25) per game entered

Payment: Please do not submit payment until you have received email confirmation of your entry. Payment must be received within 48 hrs of email confirmation for your entry to be considered accepted. Email transfers to julia.doggie.licious@gmail.com.

Running order will be determined by random draw

Refunds: will be given for any dog withdrawing for medical reasons up to the closing date. A veterinary certificate must be submitted before the trial date.

Awards - Qualifying ribbons will be presented per successful completion of trial components and rosettes for title placements

Refreshments - no amenities on site but are located close by

Crating - There will be no indoor crating available. Please be prepared to work from your vehicle.

COVID-19 Details: COVID-19 protocols will be in place. These require masking at all times when outside your own vehicle, and maintaining 2 metre social distancing between fellow competitors, trial staff and judge. Hand sanitizer will be available at the trial site.

Please be advised there is a train line which runs along the back of the trial property. The whistle can be quite loud. Dogs that have an aversion to noise may struggle. Judge will attempt to suspend runs during periods of train traffic.
