### **General Rules and Regulations**

#### **- UNOFFICIAL USE OF TRIAL ODORS NOT PERMITTED ON THE TRIAL SITE**

- Anyone caught training with odor or placing non trial hides on trial grounds will be dismissed without refund
  - Second dogs will NOT be allowed
- Open to all breeds & mixes. Dogs must be registered with the SDDA and be over six (6) months of age.
  - Dogs must be under control at all times. Keep barking to a minimum.
    - Pick up after your dogs promptly and dispose of waste as directed.
- HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL DAMAGE CAUSED BY THEMSELVES OR THEIR DOGS. This includes paying for repair or replacement of damaged property or items, including (but not limited to) scratches on vehicles, damaged objects in the search area, and so on.
- Dogs MUST be on leash when not crated or in the search areas. Do not allow your dog to approach other dogs or people (WATCH your dog when on a flexi).
  - Any handler displaying inhumane or aggressive treatment of any dog, trial officials, other handlers, or facility staff (physically or verbally) will be asked to leave without refund.
- All dogs must be on a flat collar or harness (non tightening) in the search area. Leashes may be cloth or leather of any length in the search area. Other collars / leashes ARE permitted outside of the search zones.
  - Competitors, through the submission of their entries, acknowledge that they know the Rules and Regulations and agree to abide by them. See the Master Rule Book on the SDDA web site ([www.sportingdetectiondogs.ca](http://www.sportingdetectiondogs.ca)) to familiarize yourself with all rules.
  - Running Order will be decided by random draw, and may change for each component.
- Please check in at the secretaries table upon your arrival to the site at the appointed time. No shows will be defined as handlers missing the check in time (ie not having checked in prior to the handlers briefing of that level OR the time stated in the trial run order email, whichever is earlier)
- Bitches in heat are allowed to compete, however as they will run very last in each component we ask that you notify us ASAP if your bitch is in heat so we can notify other competitors of a change in run order.
  - CRATING – There will be NO indoor crating. Please come prepared for inclement weather.
- FOOT COVERINGS – Dogs must wear durable paw coverings which will prevent accidental scratches on the front feet when inside the building
  - Minors: Minors under the age of 18 are not permitted to enter/handle dogs at this trial.

### Wait List and Onsite Entries

- If the trial fills a wait list will be maintained. Handlers will be notified of their position on the wait list and contacted if a spot becomes available.

### Entry Confirmations

Entry confirmations: Confirmations of entry receipt are automatically emailed. Please note the confirmation does not guarantee entry. If entered and the trial is full you will be notified ASAP and if you do not make it in a refund issued after the closing date.

Refunds: Refunds will be given for any dog withdrawing for medical reasons or for handlers withdrawing due to a positive COVID result. A Veterinarian Certificate must be submitted before the start of the trial for dog medical withdrawls. No other refunds will be provided except as noted in the SDDA Trial Rules.
