**Please email a photo of your dog's registration card to the trial secretary prior to the trial.**

This titling event is being held under the rules of the **Sporting Detection Dogs Association**. Open to all breeds & mixes of dogs. Dogs must be registered with the SDDA and be over six (6) months of age. Please advise us in advance if you will be bringing a bitch in heat. Training and unofficial use of odor is not permitted on the trial site.

Dogs must be always under control. Please pick up after your dogs promptly and your dog **MUST** be on leash when not crated or in the search areas. Any handler displaying inhumane or aggressive treatment of any dog, the public or other handlers (physically or verbally) will be asked to leave the premises without refund. All dogs must be on a flat collar or harness in the search area. Leashes must be cloth or leather of any length in the search area.

Competitors, through the submission of their entries, acknowledge they know the Rules and Regulations ([SDDA-Rules-2022B.docx \(live.com\)](#) or see Master Rule Book on the SDDA web site [www.sportingdetectiondogs.ca](http://www.sportingdetectiondogs.ca) to familiarize yourself with all rules.)

Competitors, through the submission of their entries, acknowledge they understand and agree to abide by prevailing provincial and applicable municipal COVID-19 protocols in place at the time of the trial, if any.

Handler/Dog Teams may enter one or all components. All three (3) components (Container, Interior, Exterior) must be successfully completed (qualifying scores earned) to earn a title; it is not necessary to complete all three on the same day. However, the SP (Special) will be added to the title of any dog who does complete the three components on the same day, at the same trial.



## GENERAL INFORMATION

**Fees:** \$35 per Component or \$90 for three components

**Payment:** Accepted method of payment is email transfer only. Email transfers to [njmckenzie@glenshielregd.com](mailto:njmckenzie@glenshielregd.com)

**Confirmation** of entry will be emailed. Please do not send payment before you receive a confirmation of entry. Once confirmation is received, you have 48 hours to email your entries. After that time, if we have not received payment, your entries will be released.

**Refunds** – Refunds will be given for any dog withdrawing for medical reasons up to closing date. A Veterinarian Certificate must be submitted before the start of the trial. If a handler is not well and cannot attend the trial, no refunds will be provided. If the trial must be cancelled due to municipal or provincial restrictions, entries will be credited and carried over for the next planned CSTC trial.

**Awards – Started / Advanced / Excellent** qualifying ribbons will be presented per component in Amateur divisions. Overall 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> Prizes will be offered for each level.

**No Shows** - Competitors who are not present as of the time of their level briefing and who have not contacted the show chair to give notice will be considered no shows.

**Refreshments** – Water and snacks will be provided to participants. Food and drinks are available in Leduc (approximately 5km from the trial venue)

**Benching** – There will be no benching indoors. All crating will be outdoors in the competitors' vehicles. Please come prepared for the weather.
